Energy, Infrastructure and Sustainable Development Summit

The Global Economic Institute for Africa (GEIA), in partnership with the Canada-Africa Chamber of Business (formerly Canada-Southern Africa Chamber of Business), has concluded plans to hold its 2015 Economic Summit at the Ramada Hotel in Toronto, Canada. The Summit is a four-day event from September 27-30, 2016 under the theme, “Energy, Extractive Industries, Infrastructure and Sustainable Development”.

Senior executives from government, industry, academia, utilities, and other organizations from across Canada, United States and Africa are being invited to this red carpet event.
